

electronic Air Waybill (eAWB)

eAWB completely replaces paper-AWB

Already as of 2019 the **electronic air waybill (eAWB)** is designated by IATA as the standard document for the transport of airfreight shipments. eAWB completely replaces the paper AWB and is the key enabler for **digitizing the airfreight transport chain**.

eAWB is available for all routings **worldwide** and for **almost all shipment** types. Currently exclusions from eAWB solely refer to live animals (AVI), Charges Collect (CC) and letter of credit shipments (activation planned in 2021).

Lufthansa Cargo fully supports IATA target of 100% eAWB penetration latest end of 2022.

- Flexible data transmission and increase of data availability
- Increased data quality and -completeness as data capture happens once
- Simplified and accelerated goods acceptance
- Environmental protection by avoiding print and transport of paper, that is not needed anymore
- Possibility of early quality check of shipment data within Lufthansa Cargo's "PreCheck"

- Booking of shipment as eAWB
- Selection of relevant type of eAWB
 - **-EAW**: no additional accompanying papers
 - -**EAP**: additional accompanying papers (e.g. pouch)
- Drop the paper AWB as it is not needed anymore
