

## "Going Paperless" with Lufthansa Cargo

## **Becoming 100% paperless**

Most consignments can already be transported paperless by air freight today. eFreight shipments offer many benefits for forwarders: by removing paper documents from processes all workflows can be simplified and digital data is always in the lead. There are two options for **eFreight shipments**:

- → **EAP** = eFreight with accompanying paper documents
- → **EAW** = eFreight without accompanying paper documents.

Lufthansa Cargo fully supports the industry goal of 100% eFreight and, additionally, offers the transport of **pure paperless shipments (EAW)**. This applies for general cargo; excluding special cargo in the first step. Moreover, for most destinations, e.g., India, no paper requirements exist by authorities.\*

\*Please note: few destinations might still require paper documentation (e.g., MEX, CAI, etc.)

All possible shipments declared as **EAW** and **delivered** to airline **without accompanying paper documents** support your shipments in a seamless, quick and transparent transport process.

## Your eFreight benefit

- Pure paperless shipments (EAW) simplify all workflows (e.g., focus to freight handling, not documentation; allow upfront preparation of delivery).
